Page 2 \* \* \* \* \* 1 2 BEGINNING OF RECORDING LABELED "DanShearer\_Response\_Voicemail" 3 MR. SHEARER: Hey, Aubrey. This is Danny 4 Shearer. I wanted to get back with you. I got your 5 e-mail earlier today. 6 7 So, yes, I did talk to the mental health center. And -- oh, my gosh, I forgot her name now. I 8 9 think it was Robin Farmer. And she is a human resource person. And that's who they directed me to 10 when I told them, you know, what was going on. 11 12 And she -- basically, here's how the mental health system stands, is they forbade me to write any 13 14 kind of letter talking about anything that had to do with the mental health center. They are saying that 15 is something that you would have to take up with them, 16 17 because I am no longer an employee. So, sorry about that, but that's kind of 18 19 where their stance is. And I explained the majority 20 of the case and the issue. And, you know, again, their point was, you know, well, it's been so many 21 22 years, and because -- if you look at the notes, you 23 know, you do -- hopefully, it's demonstrated, unless 24 it was blacked out in your notes. Everybody knew everything that was going on. 25

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1	In other words, your question about whether
2	things were done, you know, that we didn't talk to
3	Social Services about your mom's behavior, well,
4	that's a little inaccurate because Social Services via
5	Jessica Fry and Eric Stolze, was they were very, very
6	much involved involved in the treatment team and
7	involved in every angle as we walked through your
8	treatment.
9	The other thing, too, is that, you know,
10	upon when this incident with the police came, you
11	know, my notes clearly say that we were doing
12	everything we can to avoid anybody getting arrested,
13	so because that's our mission. You know, we want
14	people to stay in their home. We don't want them in
15	hospitals, and we don't want them in jail. So we were
16	doing exactly what we have committed to do.
17	So in that respect, I think what the Mental
18	Health Center is trying to say is that they feel very
19	comfortable and confident with how things were going.
20	Plus, it's documented that we were angling
21	towards discharge. So you weren't in any way, shape,
22	or form going to be, you know, involved in or engaged
23	in our kind of treatment forever. It was actually
24	considered, as I think it's written there, to, you
25	know, get you discharged and get you out.

Page 4 The other point that -- you know, I didn't 1 2 think I made it clear, because I kind of felt bamboozled in our session and kind of was taken 3 completely by surprise, much like Captain Kirk seeing 4 Khan on the screen for -- you know, in so many years. 5 And I was taken aback, not even remembering half the 6 stuff. 7 But upon, you know, further reflection, you 8 9 know, Aubrey, you were ill. Despite the fact that your mother was very ill herself, we were treating 10 your illness as well. So Dr. Eliopulos would not have 11 12 allowed us to continue treatment if he didn't think so 13 either. 14 So, again, you know, we were providing 15 treatment, and we were providing safety and keeping 16 you in the home. And we were trying to get you discharged, and hopefully you would survive 17 18 adolescence and do well for yourself, which, by the 19 way, I said, well, what about at least giving him a 20 letter for support? And they said, well, we don't know him --21 22 her. Forgive me. I'm sorry I said that. We don't 23 know the person. And it's great to hear that you've got letters of recommendation. I think the mental 24 health center is trying to tell me that you are --25

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you're on a roll. I've never and they've never heard 1 2 anyone getting bit in the ass because of things that happened to them in their adolescence. 3 4 And I don't see how your college career could be hampered by things that were going on. But, 5 you know, that's not for me to decide. I've never, in 6 7 the 28 years that I've been in this business, ever had any problems in that respect. 8 9 So it looks like since they're not going to be able for me to discuss and talk about what happened 10 in the past, I'm, at this junction, no use to you. I 11 12 don't see how -- I don't know what's going on with you today. But it sure sounds like you're doing well. 13 14 And I hope that you focus on that, that what you're 15 doing is awesome, and you continue on that track and 16 not look at the past and see how this thing could bite you in the butt. I don't see it. 17 18 But they told me to have you call them. You 19 can feel free to disagree. But I have to disagree 20 (sic) with them. They are the people that own these 21 documents, and they're the people that are saying 22 they're completely responsible, and they are demanding 23 that I stay out of it. So I wish I could help more. But there it 24 is. And I wish you well and hope you really kick ass 25
